

Pansy Block

(paper pieced)

*Thank you for choosing my pattern!
I hope you enjoy sewing it as much
as I enjoyed designing it.*

This pattern contains 4 pages, and includes:

- 3" **Pansy** block pattern, without seam allowances
- 6" **Pansy** block pattern, without seam allowances
- table of percentages for resizing 6" block when photocopying
- coloring page to experiment with your own color ideas

Important: To ensure pattern size accuracy when printing from Adobe Reader, either:

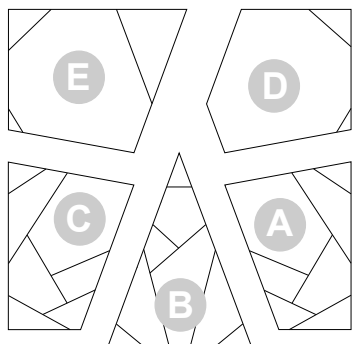
- 1) Set "Page Scaling" to None (later versions of Reader)
OR
- 2) UNcheck the "Fit to Page" box (earlier versions of Reader).

After printing the pattern pages, verify the size accuracy using the "Print Size Check" arrow, which measures exactly 1" (2.54 cm) from tip to tip.

For other common finished block sizes, photocopy a 6" block at the percentages shown in the table at right. **NOTE:** Due to the many pieces in this design, use the 3" version for blocks 4" and smaller. For a 4" block, enlarge the 3" pattern by 133%.

Remember to add 1/4" seam allowances around each section while piecing. If you like, make one photocopy at your desired finished block size, then measure and draw 1/4" seam allowances on the copied pattern. Then copy your adjusted pattern as needed for your project.

To get a finished block this size:	copy 6" block at this percentage:
5"	83%
7"	116%
8"	133%
9"	150%
10"	166%
12"	200%
14"	233%
15"	250%
16"	267%
18"	300%
20"	333%



6" Pansy Block Assembly:

- 1) Paper piece the 5 individual sections
- 2) Sew sections A and D together
- 3) Sew section B to section A+D
- 4) Sew section C to section E
- 5) Sew section A+D+B to section C+E

3" Pansy Block

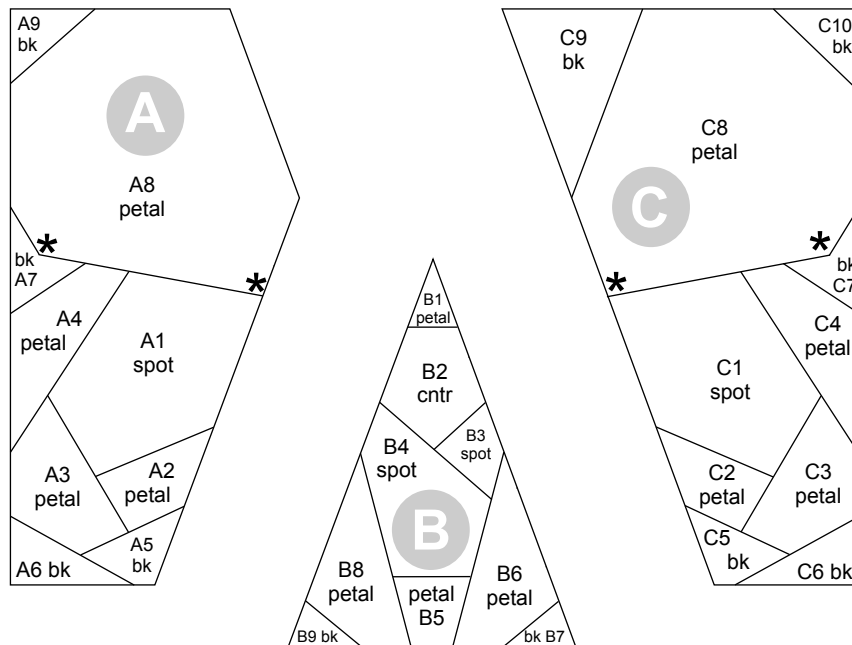
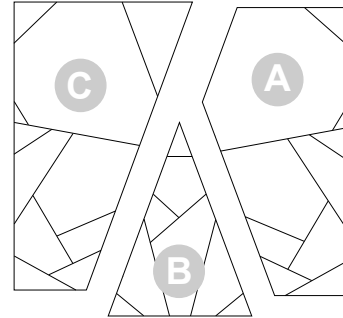
3" Pansy Block Assembly:

1) Paper piece the 3 individual sections

2) NOTE: In sections A and C, the seam for patches A8 and C8 is sewn between the two asterisks (*) ONLY. To make the "corner" of the petal, fold the outer raw edge of the patch at an angle before folding over the sewn edge. The fold should follow the line of the petal from the asterisk to the outer edge (hold up to light source to verify before pressing). The folded edge can be left as is, slip-stitched later, or secured during quilting.

3) Sew sections A and B together

3) Sew section C to section A+B



Add 1/4" seam allowances around all pattern sections.

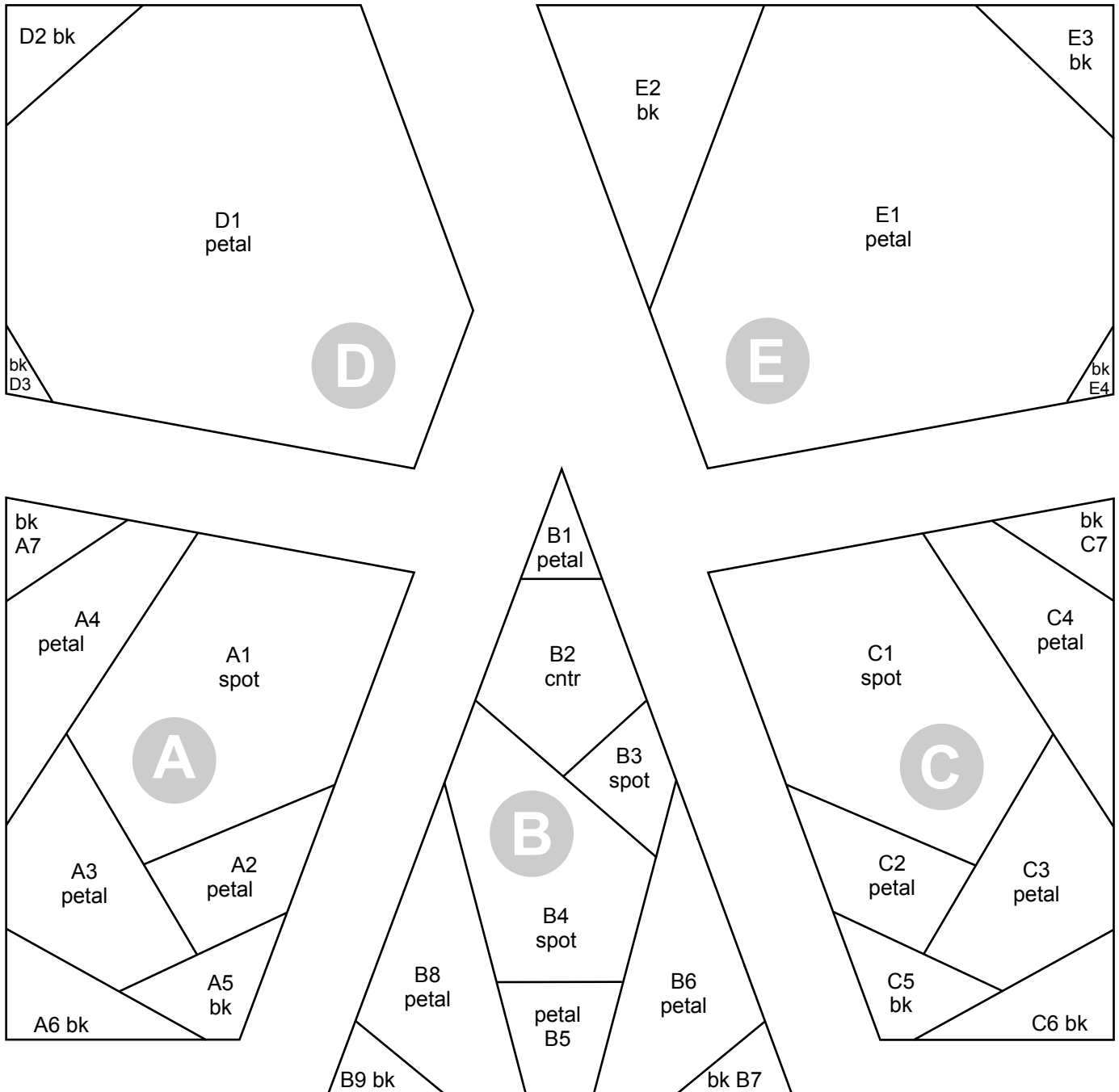
