

Grandma's Tea Party Wallhanging

Finished size about 23" x 25"

We used fabrics from: Second Generation, Celestials, Island Botanicals, and Fundamentals

Fabrics needed:

- Tea cups, tea pot body, pieced border - 9 different prints - 1 Fat Eighth (9" x 22") EACH
- Tea pot parts - medium blue - 1 Fat Eighth
- Background - tan - 7/8 yard
- First border - light blue - 1 Fat Quarter (18" x 22")
- Piping, binding - yellow - 1/4 yard
- Outer border - floral - 3/8 yard
- Backing - 7/8 yard

Make 8 photocopies of the tea cup pattern; 1 copy each of the 4 tea pot pattern pieces.

Before making the tea cups, cut a 2-1/4" x 22" strip from your tea cup fabrics and set aside for the pieced border.

First border - cut 4 strips - each 1-1/2" x 22".

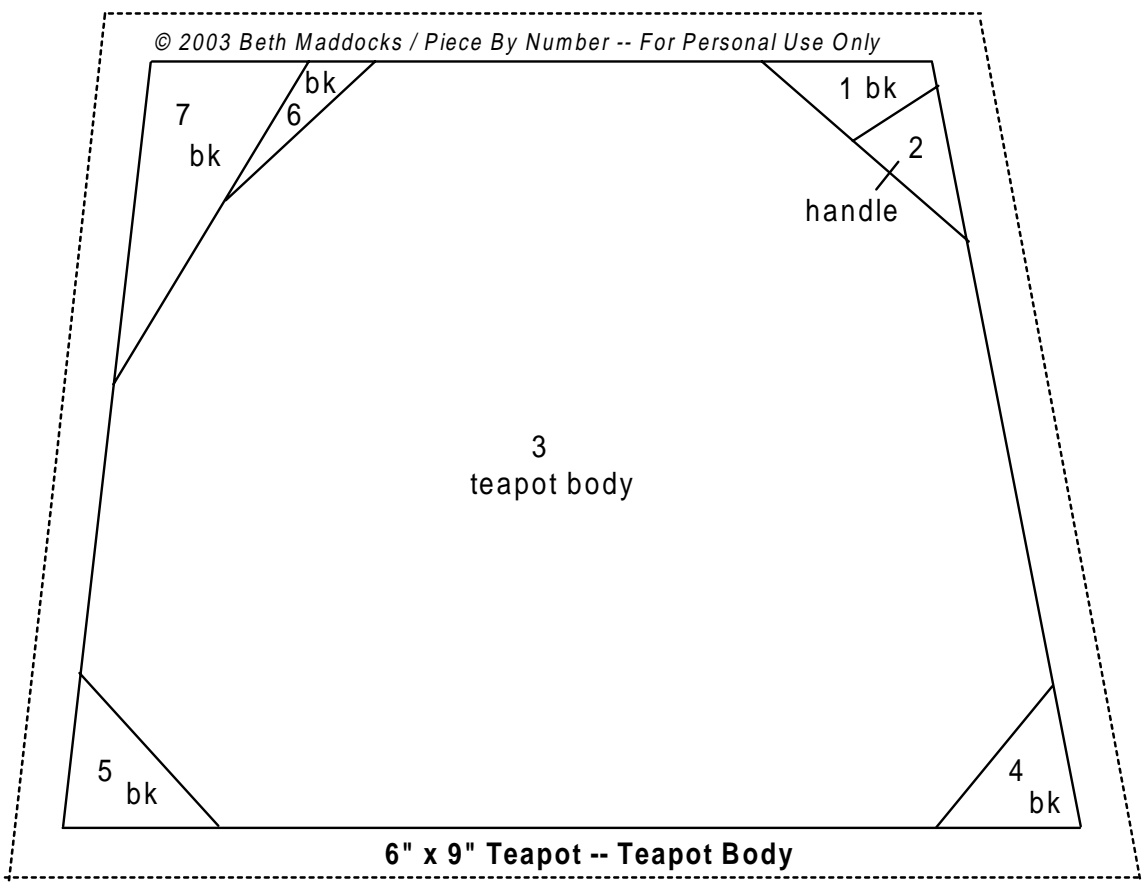
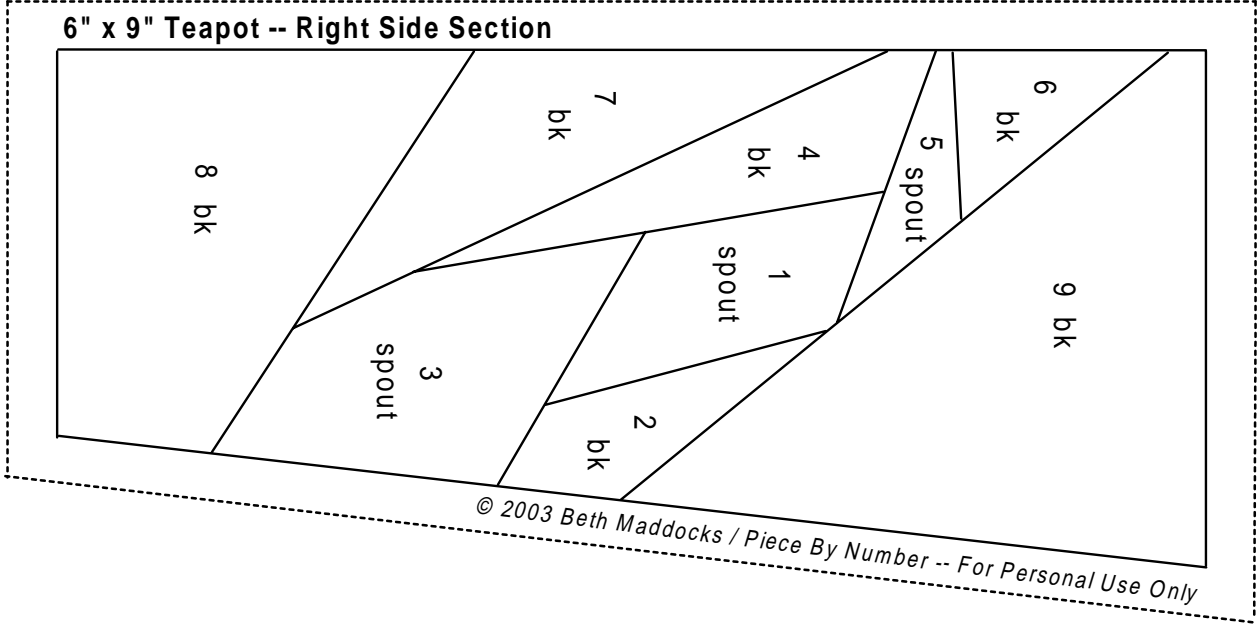
Pieced border - sew the 2-1/4" x 22" strips together and cross cut to 2-1/4".

Piping - cut two 1" strips x WOF, fold right side OUT, press and sandwich between pieced border and outer border.

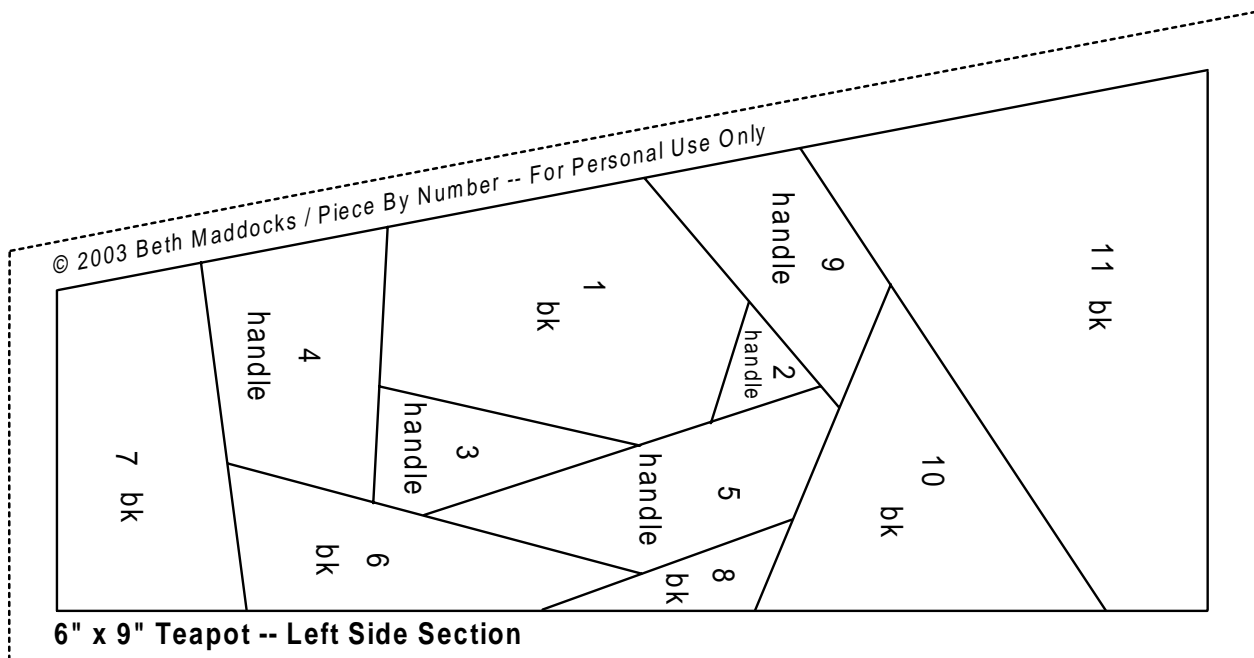
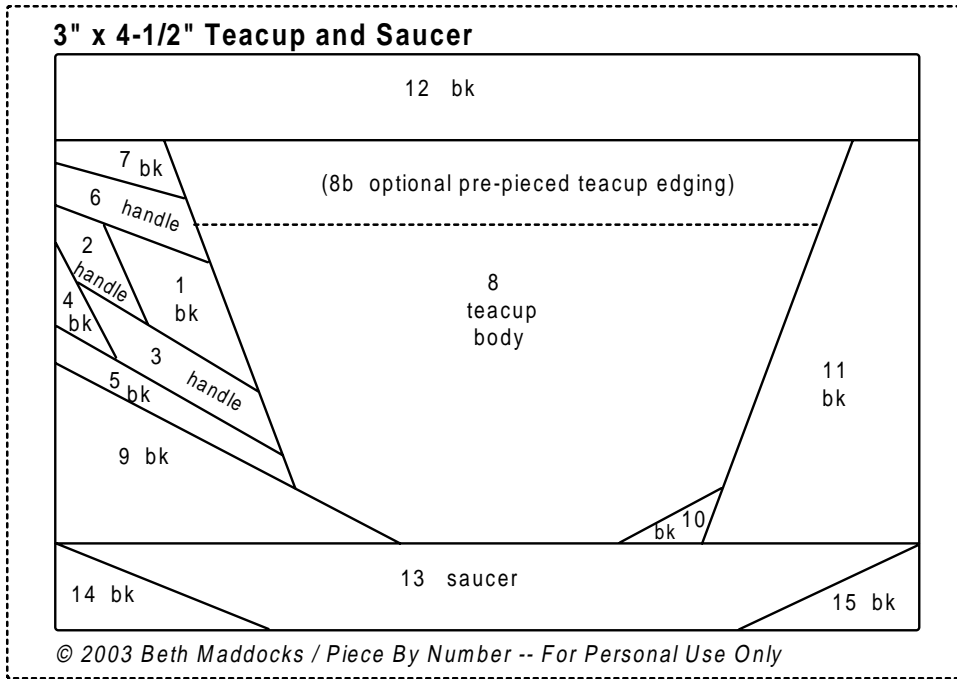
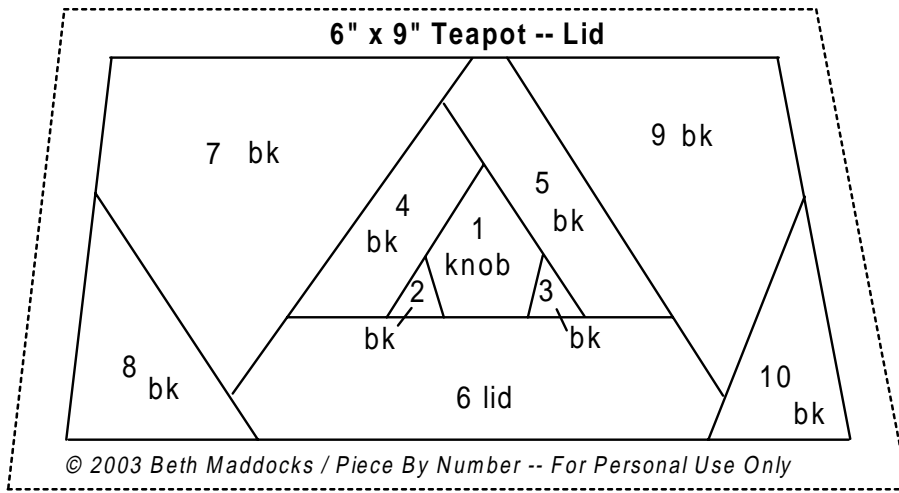
Outer border - cut four strips - each 3" x WOF.

Binding - cut 3 strips - each 2" x WOF.

Sew your blocks together following the photo. Add the borders. Sandwich, quilt, bind and enjoy!
